But God has rescued us ...



from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in Whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins



Through Christ, God
[1] pays our sin-debt
[2] throws away the record of our debt and
[3] disarms our spiritual enemies.

Christ destroys the devil's work." [1 John 3:8b] and by His cross we are fully restored to our proper relationship with God.

Yet we must take care not to turn aside from Christ as supreme & all-sufficient, falling into idolatries, worldly ways of thinking and sinful walking. Our spiritual enemies are not yet destroyed & are eager to undo our faith and haul us back into their dominion.

So: just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord live a life worthy of Him, rooted & built up in Him, pleasing Him, & overflowing with thankfulness, so you may be presented by Him holy in His sight, without blemish & free from accusation.


